<u>Year 9 & Year 10 Computer Science Residential to Disneyland Paris 5th - 7th February 2020</u>

We have an exciting opportunity to attend an educational tour of Disneyland Paris, which is arranged by Study Experiences. The tour provides an exclusive opportunity for students to discover how Computer Science is put into practice at this world famous leisure destination.

Flights to Paris will be from Leeds/Bradford airport (subject to availability), flight times will be confirmed once all deposits have been paid, students would be required to make their own way to and from the airport, accommodation will be at Disney's Hotel Cheyenne which includes an all you can eat buffet for breakfast and evening meals for the duration of the stay.

Students would need sufficient spending money to allow them to purchase lunch within the park on each day.

During their time at Disneyland Paris, students will attend two educational seminars and an interactive workshop and will work on a number of assignment projects directly related to their classroom studies. Built into this will be time for students to enjoy the park facilities.

The seminars and workshop will take key learning points from classroom studies and show how they are put into practice at Disneyland Paris. They have been created by one of the UK's leading education providers and involve Disney staff and managers, backstage video footage and practical information to help bring the curriculum to life.

The cost of this trip is £495 per student (based on all students attending), with a non-refundable deposit of £150, for the Tour Operator, on parentpay being used to confirm your place and allow flight reservations to be made. The deadline for the deposit is 5th June 2019. A consent form with medical and emergency contact details will be sent closer to the time of the trip, for accuracy purposes.
