1. Some of the places in school

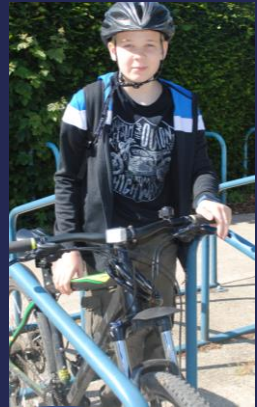
This is medical

The yard and the field

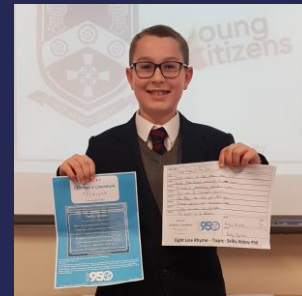
