

Brackets: really important for complex questions. Or when using negative

numbers

**Standard Form:** A way of showing really big or really small numbers.

Pi or  $\pi$ : use "shift" then "standard form"



Arrows: often used with fractions or powers

## **Powers:** Squaring. Cubing or any given

**Recurring Decimals:** Use "shift" and "x<sup>2</sup>". This is for numbers that have a repeating decimal.

S⇔D: allows us to move between decimals, fractions, surds....

DEL - deletes one thing AC - clears whole screen

ANS: gives us the most recent answer **Trigonometry Buttons:** "Sin", "cos", "tan" - use as is when finding a side. Use "shift" when finding an angle.

## Reset all Settings: "shift" "9" "3" "="

Use "shift" "AC" to turn off
