

Calculator Toolkit

Shift: works with all yellow font

Alpha: works with all pink font

Reset all Settings: "shift" "9" "3" "="

Use "shift" "AC" to turn off



Time/Minutes: Useful for converting between minutes and hours

Fractions: Use "shift" to get a mixed number.

Minus/Negative Button Good to use when we have negative numbers

Brackets: really important for complex questions. Or when using negative numbers

Standard Form: A way of showing really big or really small numbers.

Pi or π : use "shift" then "standard form"

Arrows: often used with fractions or powers

Powers: Squaring. Cubing or any given

Recurring Decimals: Use "shift" and " x^2 ". This is for numbers that have a repeating decimal.

S \leftrightarrow D: allows us to move between decimals, fractions, surds...

Trigonometry Buttons: "Sin", "cos", "tan" - use as is when finding a side. Use "shift" when finding an angle.

DEL - deletes one thing
AC - clears whole screen

ANS: gives us the most recent answer
