Dear Parent/Carer,

You'll have seen yesterday's announcement made by the government concerning our first week of term. This is what it means for us:

Year 11 should come into school as normal

Key worker children will be invited to come into school as normal. Vulnerable students and those with an EHCP are expected to be in school, a separate email will be sent. If you feel that your child should be in school and you don't receive this email, please let us know by contacting [z.hughes@bhs.hlt.academy](mailto:z.hughes@bhs.hlt.academy)

Please can you let us know if you are a keyworker and you are expecting your child to be in school Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January by emailing [keyworker@bhs.hlt.academy](mailto:keyworker@bhs.hlt.academy)

All other students will work remotely from home. If you have not completed the consent for remote learning, you will receive a separate email requesting this.

The day will start at normal time, 8.50am for those who are in school. Students at home should log on to tutor time at 9am.

I have attached the letter sent earlier in the year by Mrs Lee regarding the use of GoogleSuite. However, we will work differently during this week as all students will be expected to log into their Google classroom for each lesson, following their normal timetable. There will be one change to the timing; lessons will begin 15 minutes later than normal to allow staff movement time, to facilitate logging on to computers and to give students a break from their screens between sessions. Individual teachers will then work with their class for 45 minutes - this will include setting of independent work.

For your reference, the timetable of the school day can be found at the end of this letter.

Some of you may have concerns about access to IT, we have a database with information regarding students who might struggle and will contact these separately before Tuesday 5th January. If you feel that you will struggle with access to IT and you have not heard from us by midday on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January, please let us know by contacting [m.harvey@bhs.hlt.academy](mailto:m.harvey@bhs.hlt.academy)

If you are in receipt of free school meals, you will receive a separate email regarding arrangements.
