We are one of the largest energy production companies in the UK. We have a number of power plants, the largest of which is based in Selby, Yorkshire.


As well as producing our own sustainable biomass we sell electricity to small and medium enterprises through our customer businesses – **Opus Energy** & **Haven Power**.
